In his heart a man plans his course, but the Lord determines his steps”. (Proverbs 16:9).

A) Explanations:

1) Prayer

a) **Fasting / Prayer Weeks (THREE)** : These are special weeks chosen to fast and pray for the ministry and other related issues. Each Branch is expected to chose a day within these selected weeks when they will all fast within the day then agree on where and when to meet and pray. To facilitate this in branches where the people are living far apart, they can form restricted groups and assign a leader to each of the group, who will then make available the report of the meeting. The day and prayer venue chosen by each Branch should be made known to the National Executive or prayer Director at least 1 weeks to time. This is to enable NLs or RC who may desire to be part of any branch's prayer to know. Prayer Points or guide will be released a week before the prayer week.

b) National Prayer Days (TWO)

This day is exclusively for Fasting and prayers. Since these days are Saturdays the branches may take it as a one day retreat but prayer points or guide will once more be released a week to the day . Also **National Leaders** or **RCs** will visit the Branches during this day and pass any information as per the ministry's Vision and Policies. The venue(s) chosen for the meeting(s) should be made known at least one week to time.

B) Information Required: (Latest 28 February 2006)

We wish to request for the following information from the branch president or Centre Co-ordinator (If there are many centres the president is required to compile the final list and send to us):

- A Complete list of their members (State functions if they are leaders), E-mail / Mobile number, Status / life – undertaking or Carrier.
- Detail of branch meeting Day(s), Time (Start and End), Detail description of Meeting Venue.

C) Calendar of Events 2006:

- The Calendar of Event released is just a guide of some major programmes. Some branch programmes have been included and those that needed to be rescheduled have not been included so branches should reschedule their major programmes so as not to conflict with the Calendar. Your programmes are valid but chose a more appropriate date.
- Church, Hospital, Prisons, Orphanages, Schools etc Visitations, Sisters Forums and some Crusades are at your discretion to see the most appropriate date after haven seen the General Calender

D) Instruments / Equipment

- Any programme not found in the Calendar which may require this should be made known to the Technical Committee at least **one and a half** months (**6 Weeks**) to time and application dropped also at this time . The technical Committee should give a reply at least one month to the programme stating the clear feedback. But it is worth noting that all the transportation cost will be covered by the branch. Please to make things more efficient and consistent if any Branch applies by E-mail they should copy all the National Leaders and we also wish that the technical committee should reply the branches and copy the NLs.

E) Reports :

- This is one of the most important points, please we need all the reports of the programmes in your branches, Activity / financial reports in detail, your minute books should really be maximised for your meetings and retreats. Programme reports should be sent to the RCs one-week after the programme and the RCs will send theirs to the National Leadership. The RCs also have one week.

F) **Ministry Policies:** We are asking the presidents to help explain to their members once more the policy that governs **marriages, lost of loved ones** etc. Please many say they don't know and the reason is because they don't attend **AEPMs** and Leaders Retreats. We would not accept excuses any longer. Branch presidents will be responsible for their members who don not follow the policies. We have always said that branch presidents should time and again remind their members on ministry's issues. Where there are no RCs the reports should be sent directly to the National Leaders.
